



Hampton Parent Code of Conduct

Hampton Little League has implemented the following Parent Code of Conduct for the important message it holds about the proper role of parents in supporting their child in sports. Parents should read, understand and sign this form prior to their children participating in our league.

I agree:

- I will not force my child to participate in baseball and/or softball.
- I will remember that my child plays baseball and/or softball for his/her enjoyment, not mine.
- I will encourage my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflict without resorting to hostility or violence.
- I will teach my child that doing one's best is as important as winning so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of the game.
- I will make my child feel like a winner every time by offering praise for competing fairly and hard.
- I will never ridicule or yell at my child for making a mistake or losing a game.
- I will remember that children learn by example.
- I will applaud good plays and performances by both my child's team and their opponents.
- I will never question the umpire's judgment or honesty in public. I recognize umpires are being developed in the same manner as players.
- I will support a zero tolerance of any verbal or physical abuse.
- I will respect and show appreciation for the volunteers who give their time to baseball and softball for my child.
- I agree to abide by the principles of the Code of Conduct as set and supported by Hampton Little League.
- I also agree to abide by the rules, regulations and decisions as set by Hampton Little League and understand that failure to abide by these principles may result in disciplinary action which can include suspensions or expulsion from Hampton Little League.
